I write to ask you sign EDM 497 Humanitarian appeal for visitation rights for wives of Miami Five.

The EDM expresses concern at the plight of two Cuban women, Adriana Pérez and Olga Salanueva who have been denied visitation rights to visit their husbands, Gerardo Hernández and René González, currently detained in the US for more than 14 years.

Both women have been denied entry visas by US authorities on ten separate occasions, and in the case of Olga Salanueva, told she is permanently ineligible to apply again. Their case is supported by religious, legal and human rights organisations around the world including Amnesty International.

Please sign EDM 497 which asks only for a humanitarian gesture to grant visitation rights and allow these two women to see their husbands again.
