

Petition to Barts Health NHS Trust Board

Reinstate Charlotte Monroe, end the bullying climate

We call on Barts Health Trust Board to reinstate Charlotte Monroe, who has contributed to our local health service over 26 years as an Occupational Therapist, in the moving and handling service, and as a highly regarded union rep, who has chaired her UNISON Branch and Staff Side. She has helped to secure the future of the hospital through the Save Whipps Cross Campaign she chaired.
